Elections and Referenda

Policy Type Operational Policy Purpose

To outline the expectations of TKUSA elections and referenda in a fair, open, and transparent.

Definitions

The **Chief Returning Officer (CRO)** is the General Manager of TKUSA and is charged with the responsibility of ensuring that the elections and referenda proceed according to bylaws, policy and procedure.

The **Deputy Returning Officer (DRO)** is the person appointed by the CRO who is charged with supporting the election process and CRO.

A candidate is a qualified person who seeks to obtain an elected position.

Campaigning refers to the process of a candidate promoting themselves and their desire to run for a position and their intentions in that role. It can also be the candidate seeking to influence the outcome of a particular referendum question.

Policy Statement

- 1. Awareness of all aspects of its elections or referenda will be promoted to the members.
- 2. The administration of elections and referenda will be fair and impartial.
- 3. TKUSA's General Manager is the Chief Returning Officer (CRO) for all elections and referenda.
 - 3.1. The CRO will appoints a Deputy Returning Officer (DRO).
 - 3.2. The CRO will approve all campaign materials
- 4. The duration and scope of campaigning, as well as the use of campaign materials, must be limited and defined.
- 5. A grievance and appeal process exists.
- 6. Opportunities will be provided for students to interact with all candidates
- 7. The King's University requirements regarding campaigning and materials must be adhered to.
