Procedure Statement

1. Referenda

- 1.1. Referenda may be approved by one of two methods:
 - 1.1.1. The General Council may approve a referendum question to be presented to TKUSA's membership.
 - 1.1.2. TKUSA's membership may present a petition to the General Council containing a referendum question, along with the names, signatures, and student identification numbers of at least one-fifth of TKUSA's membership.
- 1.2. In order to be binding on TKUSA, a referendum question must receive at least two-thirds of votes in favour by all TKUSA members who voted.
- 1.3. Should a question receive more than half, but less than two-thirds of votes in favour by those TKUSA members who voted, the General Council may make the outcome binding via special resolution.
- 1.4. Any TKUSA member, including representative(s), may run a campaign in favour of or opposed to the referendum question. Only one campaign may be registered in favour of, or opposed to, the question at any time.
